

Improving Higher Education for Santa Fe Residents on August 3, 2010

On Aug. 3, Santa Fe Community College will ask voters to decide on a \$35-million bond issue to provide much-needed support for the maintenance and energy-efficiency of its campus. The measure would also support construction of a Higher Education Center, a centrally-located complex in Santa Fe where the community college would partner with the state's universities to enable local students to earn advanced degrees.

\$3 million of the bond issue is slated for campus building renovations, including turning a large, dirt-floored storage area into a black-box performing arts space. Please consider supporting the bond issue in August. Go to www.votesfcc.com for more information.
